Social Work is a human rights based profession. Germany ratified the CRPD in 2009. A big aim for the still marginalized group of persons with disabilities was and is inclusion. She worked excellent with the triple mandate to argue and to fight for the clients rights and to promote inclusion in her organisation. With the personality theory by Rogers, the needs theory by Obrecht and the CRPD (article 27 (1)) she was able to convince the management of her organisation. She showed in a professional way how important it is to legitimate Social Work.
